# Path to Plate

## PRODUCTION CYCLE OF BEEF

COW-CALF OPERATIONS



- Ranchers produce cattle for stockers and feedlots

STOCKER OPERATIONS



- Ranchers graze weaned calves up to 900 pounds

FEEDLOT OPERATIONS



- Cattle are fed until they weigh 900-1,400 pounds

- Texas has over 130,000 cow-calf operations

- Calves eat nearly 25 pounds of grass or hay daily

- Texas raises more than 5 million calves annually

- Mature calves are marketed to feedlots

**Annually, over 5 million calves are born on over 130,000 cow-calf operations in Texas! With an inventory of over 11.8 million head, Texas is the top cattle producing state in the nation. Fun fact: A full grown cow can eat more than 25 pounds of hay or grass every day!**

**Three ounces of lean beef (about the size of a deck of cards):**

**Contains nearly half of the daily value of protein.**

**Has 7 grams of fat, 3 grams of saturated fat, and 75 mg of cholesterol**

**Is considered “nutrient-dense,” and contains protein, iron, zinc, and B-vitamins. Beef may also help you maintain a healthy weight, build muscle and fuel a healthy and active lifestyle**




